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### SUMMARY OF MILITARY OCCUPATIONS

13. TITLE—DESCRIPTION—RELATED CIVILIAN OCCUPATION

#### NAVIGATOR

Served with 44th Bombardment Group on anti-submarine patrol in the Gulf of Mexico and the Carribean Sea for three months and with the 2nd Emergency Rescue Squadron covering bomber and fighter missions to rescue downed airmen in the Southwest Pacific Area for seven months. Also was supervisor of training and training devices on staff of the base commander at Barksdale Field, La. for two years. Was in charge of ground school navigation, link training, and celestial navigation trainers and was responsible for the activities of approximately 100 men who were operators, instructors, and mechanics on such equipment. Was responsible to see that all bomber crews received efficient training in the synthetic devices in correlation with other phases of air training.
