When qrs or billets are furnished per diem will be paid in accordance with prevailing rates. Auth is granted to make variations and to proceed to such other places as may be necessary for the completion of this mission.

From time of departure from Continental US until arrival at perm overseas sta, amt of per diem is atzd for a maximum of forty-five (45) days.
